#### **Meet Our Pastoral Search Team**



**RICHARD STURM** is Secretary of the Ministry Council, as well as Chair of the Team of Elders. He has served the church in several roles over the past 40 years, and for 12 years was Associate Minister at The Park during his years at Union Seminary as an M. Div. and Ph.D. student. He also served over 20 years as a Professor and Director of the New York Program of New Brunswick Theological Seminary at St. John's University in Oueens.

**CONSTANCE PACKARD M.S.W.,** is a retired family therapist. For many years she was deeply involved in providing alternative community-based treatments and services for people with serious mental illness. She has been a member of the Park for five years, is Vice Chair of the Ministry Council, a Deacon and a member of the Building Committee.





**REVEREND DR. MARIA LOPEZ** has worked with the incarcerated for over 20 years. She is a graduate of New York Theological Seminary, and has completed a Doctorate of Ministry at New Brunswick Theological Seminary. While she was working at Rikers Island, Maria became a member of The Park. John Payne was her pastor. He and members of the church visited Rikers and engaged in dialogue with the incarcerated.

**DR. NADEIGE GENECE-SEKYIAMAH** is a Pediatrician at NYU Langone Hospital and has been an active member of *The Park*, since 2010. She is a member of the Gospel Choir, and has served on the Minister of Music Search Team. She and her husband Stephen have two children, Simone and Samuel.





**HEATHER BICKHAM** joined *The Park* in 2009. She has been a stagehand/actor and has used her skills for numerous projects, including Theater 1010, the Columbari Troupe, the production of Noah's Ark, and Mark Leach's play. Heather is also a personal trainer, and has used those skills to lead a strength and conditioning class. She has volunteered in our choir, our Bazaar, the Building Committee, the youth group's Halloween party, and the Saturday Community Lunch Program. ## **Update on our Mission Efforts**



On Friday, November 20 at 10:30 am, Rev. Luis-Alfredo Cartagena Zayas led the Jericho Walk around Federal Plaza. The Jericho Walk is a peaceful faith action where participants walk around the Federal Building seven times and petition the Lord as we battle the powers and principalities on Immigration Reform.

The Park is a member of The New Sanctuary Coalition of New York City, and participates in this interfaith network of congregations, organizations, and individuals, standing publicly in solidarity with families and communities resisting detention and deportation in order to keep families unbroken.

We recognize that unjust global and systemic economic relationships and racism form the basis of the injustices that affect immigrants. We seek reform of United States immigration laws to promote fairness, social, and economic justice. This is especially true today when the political elite seek to justify inaction by blaming the victims and instilling fear in the hearts of citizens.



Also on Friday, November 20, Park members, Rev. Hugo Monroy and Rev. Luis-Alfredo Cartagena Zayas participated in a press conference on the steps of City Hall as a coalition of immigration advocates marked the one-year anniversary of President Obama's announcement of Executive Actions Providing Immigration Relief.

New Yorkers are calling on the Supreme Court to take up an Immigration Relief Lawsuit to enable millions of families the right to stay together. Participants include: Steven Choi, executive director of the New York Immigration Coalition, Council Member Carlos Menchaca, Commissioner Nisha Agarwal of the

Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs, Juan Cartagena, President and General Counsel of Latino Justice PRLDEF, Rosa Gaona, member of Cabrini Immigrant Services, Jong-Min You, member of MinKwon Center for Community Action, Manuel Lazo, leader at Make the Road New York, Teresa Gutierrez and Onleilove Alston, Executive Director, Faith Leader at Faith in NY. A statement of support was read by City Council Speaker Melissa Mark-Viverito.

On Saturday November 21, The Park participated in the Thanksgiving Lunch at our sister church, La Segunda del Bronx. As part of the Northeastern Region's Outreach, our two congregations, motivated by Jesus' love, joined in service to members of the community of the



South Bronx. We were able to serve 250+ meals. La Iglesia Cristiana la Segunda extends Thanksgiving wishes

to all members of The Park near and far.

First, they are drafting a congregational profile (to present to prospective candidates for our next Senior Minister), using the report of the Transition/Development Team.

Second, they are drafting a ministerial profile, to describe the responsibilities of our Senior Minister -- and the qualities, skills, gifts, and graces we are seeking in our next Senior Minister.
